



The City Council of the City of Midfield, Alabama met in regular session on Monday, February 12, 2007, at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Gary Richardson presiding.

Councilmember Janice Anderson gave the invocation.

Cedric Brown called roll, the following members were present: Terry Adams, Janice Anderson, Reginald Wilson, Jimmie Robinson, Velma Johnson, and Mayor Gary Richardson. Cedric Brown acted as clerk. A quorum being present the meeting was opened for the transaction of business.

**Approval of published minutes from last Council meeting:** Councilmember Reginald Wilson made the motion to approve the published minutes from the last regular Council meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Janice Anderson. A roll call vote resulted in a unanimous vote.

**Approval of payment of bills:** Councilmember Janice Anderson made the motion to suspend rules of immediate consideration of payment and Councilmember Velma Johnson seconded the motion. Councilmember Velma Johnson made the motion to approve the payment of the February #1 bills totaling \$ 44,051.47. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Janice Anderson. A roll call vote resulted in a unanimous vote.

**Approval of Resolution No. 2007-08:** Ratifying the named depository of funds and updating the signature cards for the City of Midfield for all banks accounts which are located at Wachovia Bank. The check signers are: Mayor Gary Richardson; Mayor Pro-tem Reginald Wilson; Cedric M. Brown, City Clerk/Treasurer and Sherrell F. Thomas, Administrative Assistant II. Councilmember Velma Johnson made the motion to approve Resolution No.2007-08. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Janice Anderson. All members present voted aye passing the motion unanimously.

**Approval of Resolution No. 2007-09:** Authorizing an Appropriation to the March of Dimes for its 2007 campaign the sum of \$1,000.00. Councilmember Janice Anderson made the motion to approve Resolution No.2007-9. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Velma Johnson. All members present voted aye passing the motion unanimously.

**Open Meeting to the Public:** Richard Shows presented a petition regarding trucks speeding on B.Y. Williams Drive. Chief Ron White responded by saying that they conducted a speed check. They clocked over sixty (60) vehicles. The average speed clocked was 37 mph in a 30 mph zone. The highest clocked speed was 39 mph. Mayor Richardson requested that the police monitor the area from 1:00 am to 7:00 am.

**Randy Davis spoke on no police officer being located at the elementary school.** There is a problem with vehicles driving down the wrong one-way. Chief White stated that he will look into this situation.

**Adjournment:** Councilmember Janice Anderson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Reginald Wilson seconded the motion. All members present voted aye passing the motion unanimously.
