

Meeting Minutes City of Midfield, Alabama City Council

The City Council of the City of Midfield, Alabama met in special session on Tuesday, October 8, 2013 at 6:30 pm with Mayor Gary Richardson presiding.

Councilor Janice Anderson presented the invocation. Mayor Gary Richardson led attendees in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Agenda: Councilor Jimmie Robinson made a motion to approve the agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilor Janice Anderson. All members present voted "aye", passing the motion unanimously.

Approval of Resolution No. 2013-53: Authorizing the City Clerk to transfer funds from Special Projects Account to General Fund for the next two months to pay bills. Councilor Janice Anderson made the motion to approve Resolution 2013-53. The motion was seconded by Councilor Terry Adams. All members voted "aye", passing the motion unanimously.

Approval of Resolution No. 2013-54: Authorizing the Mayor to enter into an Agreement with RDS for Alcohol Tax Collections: Councilor Terry Adams made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2013-54. The motion was seconded by Councilor Jimmie Robinson. All members present voted "aye", passing the motion unanimously.

Approval of Ordinance No. 2013-3: Adoption of Code of Ordinances: Councilor Terry Adams made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2013-3. The motion was seconded by Councilor Jimmie Robinson. All members voted "aye", passing the motion unanimously.

Report from the Mayor: The mayor informed the council he reviewed payroll costs for the past three years. He stated, "The average monthly payroll cost in 2011was \$141,000.00 and it has steadily increased to \$286,243.72 in 2013. We need to consider decreasing our payroll expenses."
