

Meeting Minutes City of Midfield, Alabama City Council

The City Council of the City of Midfield, Alabama met in special session on Wednesday, September 2, 2009 at 6:00 P.M. with Mayor Richardson presiding.

Councilmember Velma Johnson gave the invocation.

Tameeka Ephriam called roll. The following members were present: Reginald Wilson, Velma Johnson, Terry Adams, Janice Anderson and Jimmie Robinson. Tameeka Ephriam acted as clerk. A quorum being present the meeting was opened for the transaction of business.

Approval of changing the hours of operation for the community center: Councilmember Terry Adams made the motion to change the hours of operation of the community center to Monday-Thursday 12:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and closed Friday & Sunday. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Reginald Wilson. All members present voted aye passing the motion unanimously.

Approval of Midfield Municipal Court changing to two times a month: Councilmember Velma Johnson made a motion to approve court changing to two times a month. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Reginald Wilson to approve court changing to two times a month. All members present vote aye passing the motion unanimously.

Approval of Fire Dept. changing to one medic per shift: Councilmember Reginald Wilson made a motion to approve fire department changing to one medic per shift. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Janice Anderson to approve one medic per shift. A roll call vote resulted in Councilmember Adams- Nay, Councilmember Anderson- Yes, Councilmember Robinson-Yes, Councilmember Johnson- Yes, Councilmember Wilson- Yes, Mayor Richarson- Yes, passing the motion.

Report from the Mayor: The Mayor announced he promoted Lt. Dudley to Police Chief and Sgt. Belcher to Lt. position. The Mayor also reported that the police and fire department is in the process of hiring additional personnel.
