Jeff Zissette gave a briefing on AMIC's visit, which is to insure that the City of Midfield remains in compliant with safety standards. He didn't foresee any problems. Also, Jeff encouraged everyone to call the Midfield Police Department, if they saw someone dumping illegally.

Sgt. Bell stated that the Midfield Police Department is in the process of upgrading its technology, which would decrease an enormous amount of paperwork. Citizens will eventually be able to text 911 for emergencies, due to the upgrades. Also, Sgt. Bell discussed the increase in crime within the Midfield community.

Report from Council:

Councilor Terry Adams suggested giving out a Beautification award to Midfield citizens with the best Christmas decorations. He proposed forming a committee to view the homes in the community by December 19, 2016.

Councilor Janice Anderson stated that she was very excited about the new team, and encouraged everyone to work together.
