ORDINANCE No. 2022.08-70

An Ordinance amending Ordinance Sec.50-40 (b)

Be it Ordained As follows;

Section 1. The costs for providing garbage collection services for each single-family dwelling unit, duplex, townhouse, apartment, business or other entity being provided garbage collection services, (hereinafter referred to collectively as "unit") which generate four or fewer cans of garbage, or four or fewer cans of refuse per week, shall be subject to the levy and collection of a garbage collection fee. household has increased tremendously over the years and the fee for proving garbage collection services currently set at \$20 per household has not changed since first imposed on September 24, 2001;

Section 2. Yet the City's cost to provide those services exceeds the amount of fees collected in providing those services by \$15.10 per unit.

Section 3. Because the City's general fund is being negatively impacted because of the deficit created, the City must either reduce the collections from twice a week to collections once a week, reduce the funding for other critical governmental functions such as fire and police protection, dely the purchase of needed equipment, neglect the paving of roads and/or neglect repairs and maintenance to vehicles and buildings;

Section 3. On November 14th, 2022, the City held a public hearing for the purpose allowing its citizens to speak in opposition to or support of the City Council consideration of increasing the garbage collection fee by \$15.10 per unit. After being presented all options to address the fee collection shortfall, no persons opposed the fee increase.

Section 4.

Sec. 50-40 (b) is hereby amended to provide as follows;

Sec. 50-40. Billing.

(b) The fee for the mandatory garbage collection service continues to be \$35.10 per month, per unit.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
