**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO, 2011-7,  
MIDFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE. ARTICLE VLL, ENTITLED, “SMOKE-  
FREE AIR” TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL STIPULATIONS  
CONTAINED IN ORDINANCE NO. 2011-7, §11, ENTITLED, “WHERE  
SMOKING NOT REGULATED.”**

Be It Ordained that Ordinance N. 2011-7 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

**Section 2011-7A—Where Smoking not regulated**

Notwithstanding any other contrary, smoking shall not be prohibited in any Cigar Bar in which the primary activity is the sale, manufacture or promotion of cigars or cigar accessories and in which the sale of other products (with the exception of on premise alcohol sales) is merely incidental, nor shall smoking be prohibited in a Hookah Bar, whose business that devotes a minimum of ten percent of net floor space to the display, storage and sale of tobacco products, and does not permit the on premise use of tobacco products not purchase on the premise. In addition, a hookah bar must contain a functioning commercial grade humidor with a minimum interior area of not less than 100 square feet and a smoke evacuation system adequate to ensure that smoke from its premises does not infiltrate into areas where smoking s prohibited. The system must be separate from the establishment HVAC system, vent to the exterior, and be approved by the city building inspector as having adequate capacity, so patron under the age of 21 is allowed in a hookah or cigar bar.


