An ordinance amending Midfield, Alabama, <u>Code of Ordinances</u>, Article 11- Wreckers, Section 58-21 conditions to Issuance of License.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIDFIELD THAT Article 11, SECTION 58-21(2) OF THE Midfield, AL, Code of Ordinances, IS HEREBY AMENDED TO PROVIDE AS FOLLOWS:

(2) In order to obtain a business license to operate a wrecker or tow-in service within the city or police jurisdiction of the city, an applicant must obtain a liability insurance policy providing coverage in the amount of \$100,000.00 for each personal injury. \$300,000.00 injury coverage for each accident and \$25,000.00 property damage coverage for each accident, which policy must be kept in full force and effect during the term of the license issued to the applicant. Every policy required herein must contain an endorsement providing for 15 days' notice to the city in the event of any material change or cancellation. The properly licensed wrecker/tow-in service must be located within 2 miles of the Midfield City Hall. However, in the event that no wrecker/tow-in service is available to respond when contacted by the police department to provide the wrecker/tow-in service or when a private person requests a particular wrecker/tow-in service any person having a wrecker/tow-in service located within 5 miles of the City of Midfield, Alabama City Hall can be used.

This Amendment to Ordinance Article 11, Section 58-21(2), shall go into effect immediately upon the passage, approved and publication as requested by law.
